

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I register to walk for Easterseals Crossroads at the Walking for Dreams event? Visit

How much does it cost to participate? We ask that each individual raises \$35 or family (two adults and their children under 22) raise \$75 to participate in the walk; or your team needs to raise enough as a whole to cover each walker signed up. Children under 22 are free, but donations are appreciated.

Is the donation for my participation tax deductible? Yes. All of monies donated toward the Walking for Dreams event are tax-deductible as allowed by law.

Can I include my family in my registration? Yes. If you select the "Family" registration type, please provide the names and ages of the family members that will be included in your registration.

Can I create a team, join a team or register as an individual?

Yes. You will be given the option to create or join a team during the registration process.

Can I create a team after I've already registered for the Walking for Dreams – Indy walk?

Yes. Log back into your account by clicking "sign in" link in the top right hand corner of the event registration page and click the "Join" button under "Join/create a team" option on your account home page.

Who do I make my registration fee and/or donation out to for this event? Please make all checks payable to Easterseals Crossroads and add WFD 2019 in the memo line for check payments. Cash and credit card payments will also go directly to Easterseals Crossroads as well, less the processing fees for donations via credit card.

What if I register and can't make it? We would hate for you to miss the fun, but if for some reason you can't attend, we appreciate your fundraising efforts on our behalf! Unfortunately, money raised is non-transferable.

Is there pre-packet pickup for this event? No. Pre-packet pickup is not available for the Walking for Dreams event. Check-in will open at 1 p.m. on Sunday, May 19, at Buggs Temple.

What time do we meet on Sunday, May 19? We ask that all walkers for Easterseals Crossroads check-in by 1:30 p.m. for a photo opportunity prior to the walk. Registration opens at 1 p.m. The walk begins at 2 p.m.

Are strollers, wagons and dogs allowed? Yes. The canal is wheelchair accessible. In addition, strollers, wagons and dogs are all allowed. Please note, bicycles, tricycles and skateboards are not allowed.

What if it rains? Event takes place rain or shine unless the walk organizers determine it is unsafe to walk.

Where do I park? Street parking is available along 11th Street, Senate and Capital Avenues. There is free parking at the IU Health Fairbanks Building Lot located at the corner of 11th & Senate Ave. (Gates will be open from 11 a.m. - 5 p.m.)

What do I need to bring with me to the walk? Please bring your completed form and pledges to Buggs Temple on Sunday, May 19. Easterseals Crossroads will be accepting donations and registration at the Easterseals Crossroads table. Look for our signage as we will be one of 16 organizations Walking for Dreams on Sunday, May 19.

What will be provided onsite? Water, bananas and granola bars will be provided onsite, as well as dog treats (sponsored by Delectable Dane) and doggy pools. You will also receive a ballcap upon check-in at the Easterseals Crossroads check-in table.

Can I turn in money at the walk? Yes! We take all forms of payment – cash, checks and credit cards.
